"Artist's books" we will define as a book made by an artist (and we'll be exploring making artist's books next week).

Following on from last week's session when we began to tune into [how paper can become three-dimensional to create forms with personalities](#), this week we gave ourselves an hour (!) to create a piece of book art using mixed media and paper manipulation techniques.
