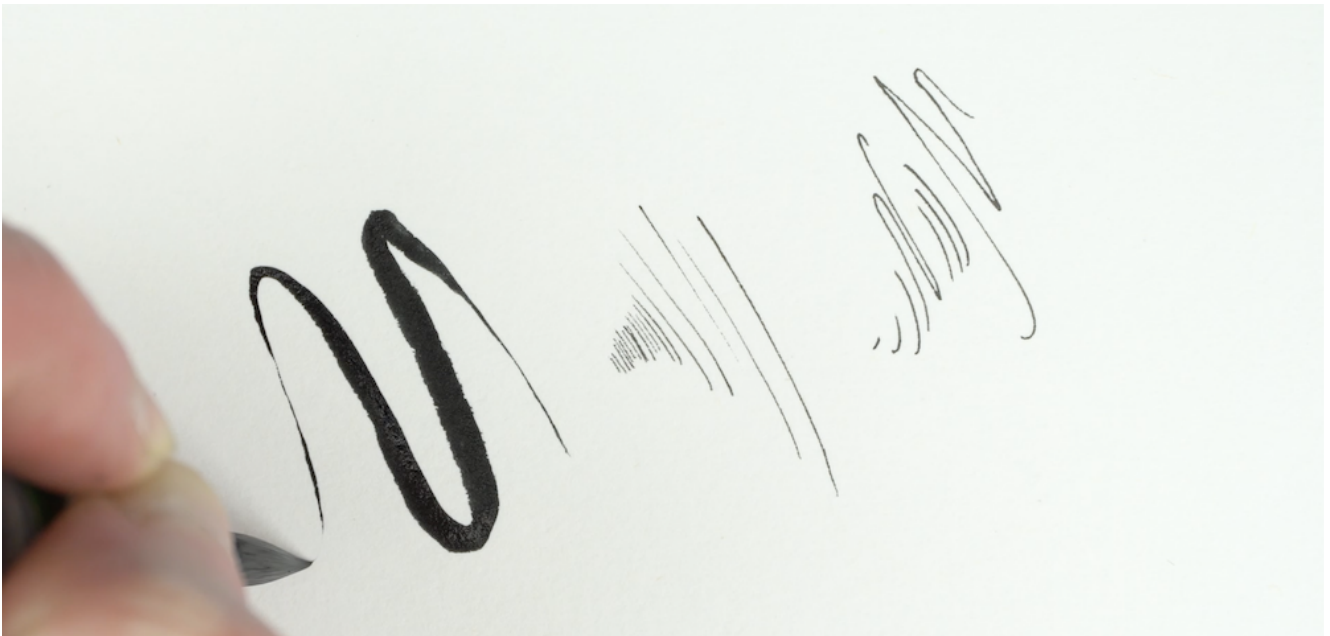


Session Recording: Exploring Line Weight

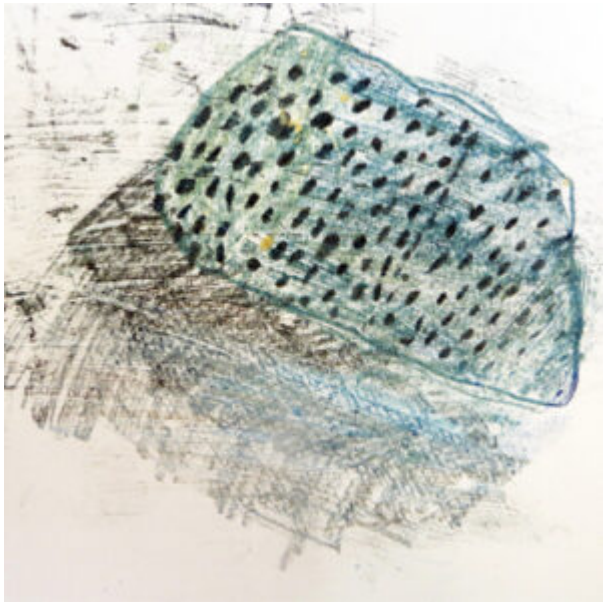
