It includes a thought-provoking, group drawing exercise on how meaning can become lost or altered as the 'message' moves further from the source; a time critical exhibition challenge; a practical making project that has to be completed within a clear set of rules, which actually opens up numerous creative options for the student and illustrates the benefit of documenting thoughts and processes; and two exercises centered around the student's ownership and management of their own studio space allocated within the classroom.

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
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


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
