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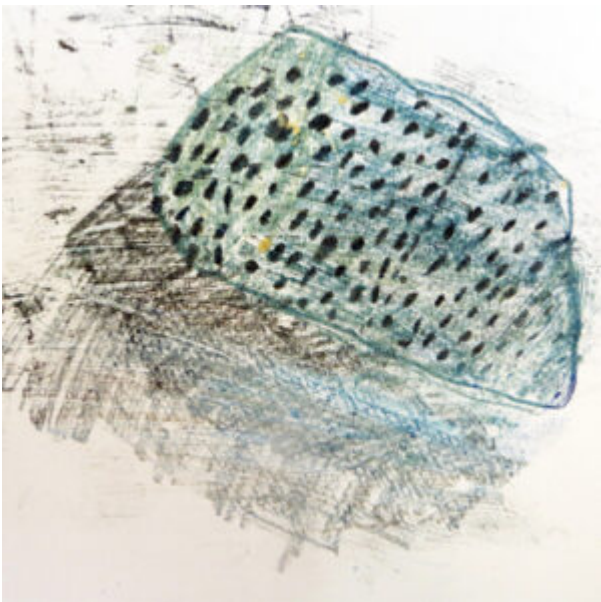
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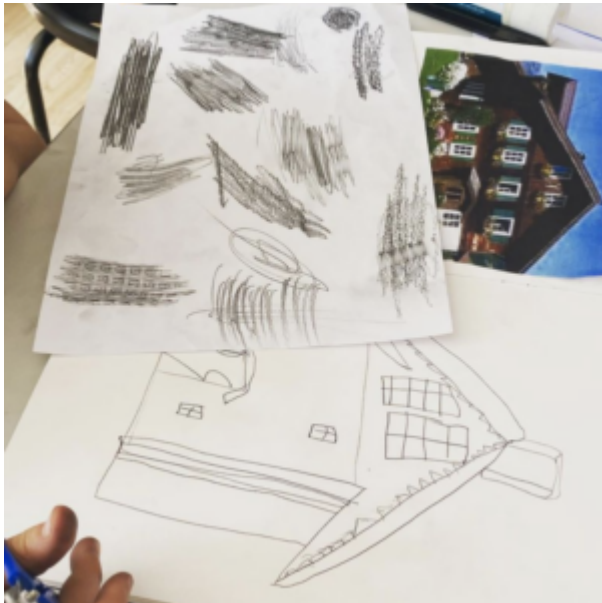


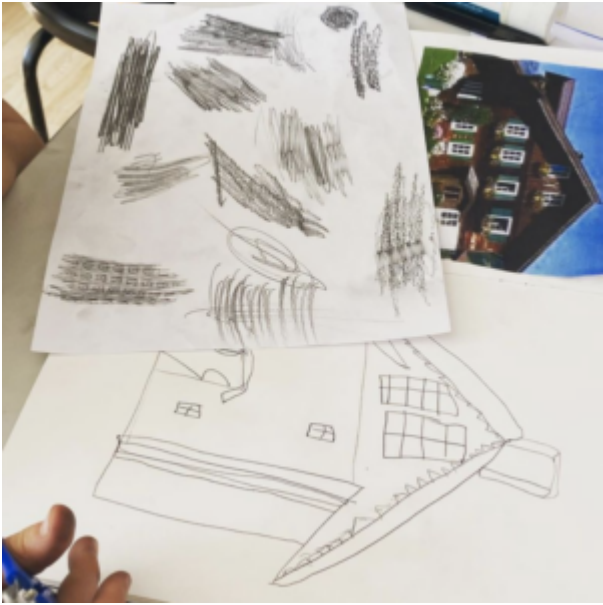
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Following on from using the grid method to scale up simple drawings, children worked on collage and construction to transform their drawings into sculptures.

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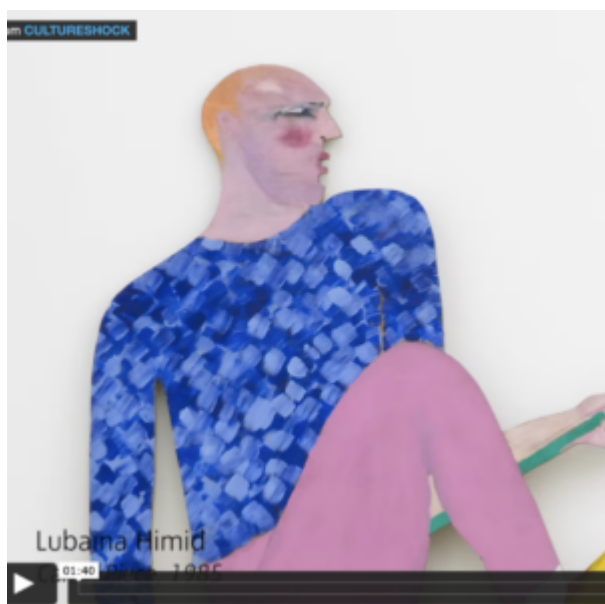
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
