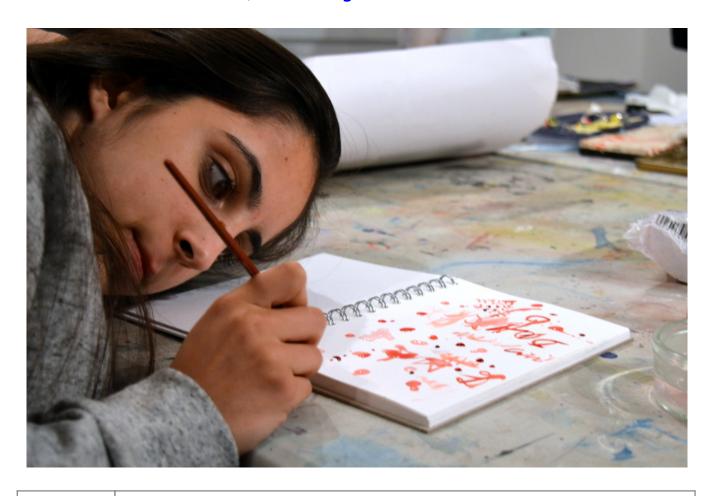
Teenagers Write A Letter, A Postcard, A Poem or A Narrative in Invented Text




