Please feel able to comment on other people’s images, and to share your own experience. We hope you will join us for this fun challenge!

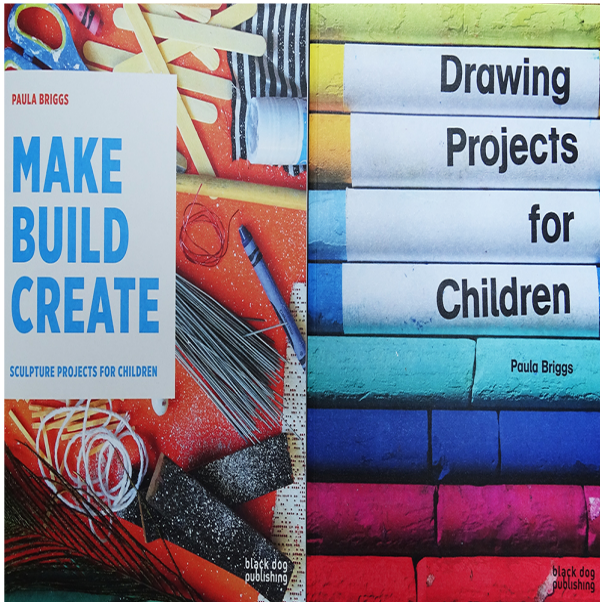

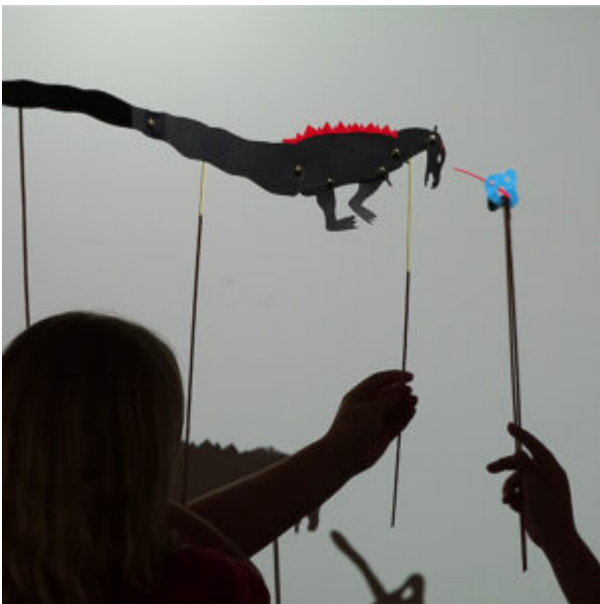
