

# **Sculptural Birds in Flight by Teenage Makers**

In this workshop teenagers played with sculptural ideas around building form and mass, tension and scale by combining materials from Scrap Stores.

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## **Autobiographical Suitcase Pop-Up Gallery**

This resource shares how 8, 9 and 10 year old children created a home for all of their sculptures and paintings in the form of a cardboard suitcase which doubled up as a pop-up gallery.


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
