*In this workshop, children were introduced to a new approach to drawing cartoon animals. Instead of constructing characters from simple shapes, such as a circular body and oval limbs, they learned to draw cartoon animals by following a guided process.*

In this way, they expanded their visual vocabulary and acquired the drawing skills needed to make their cartoon drawings unique and personal.*
