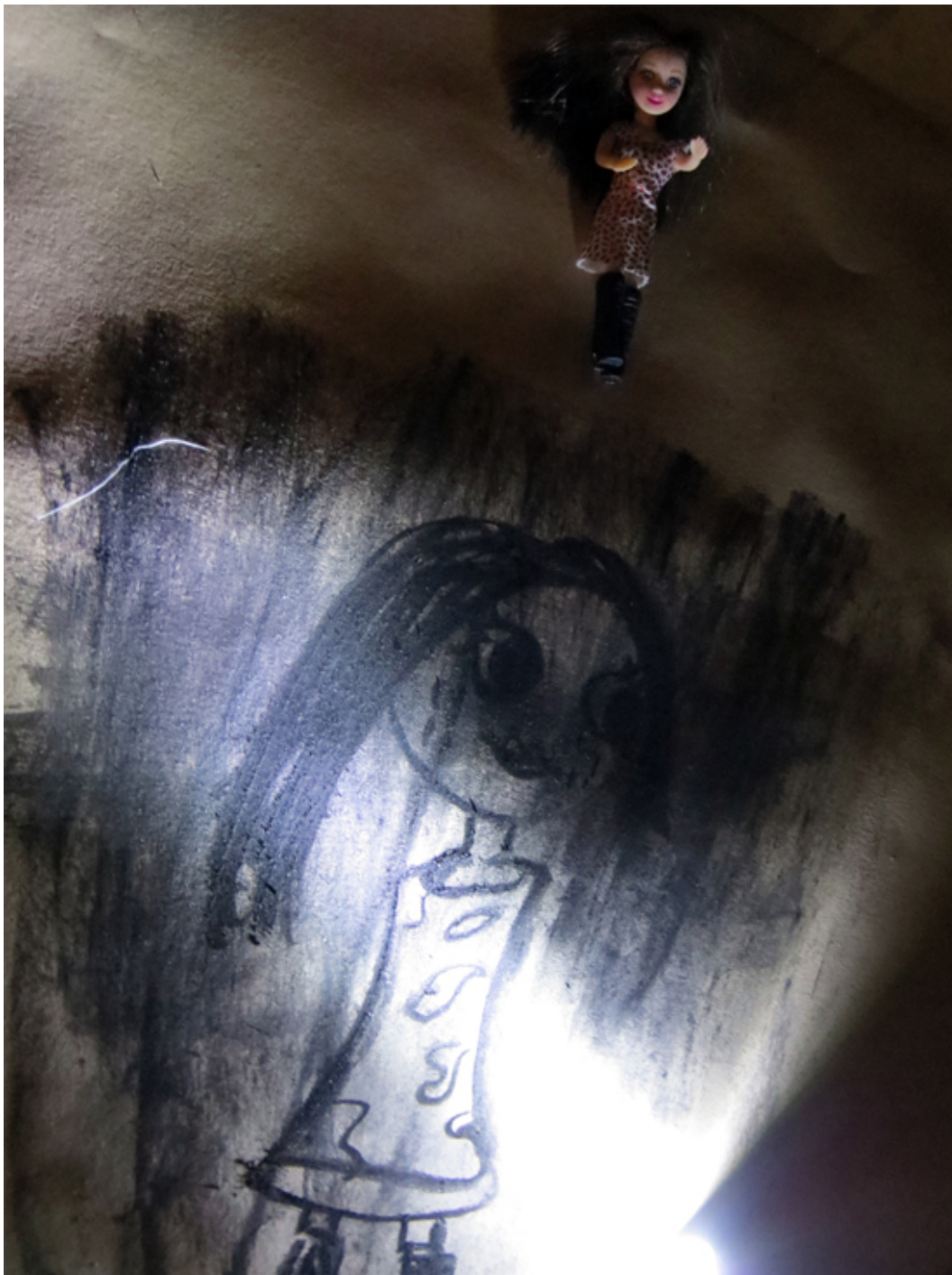


Drawing by Torchlight
