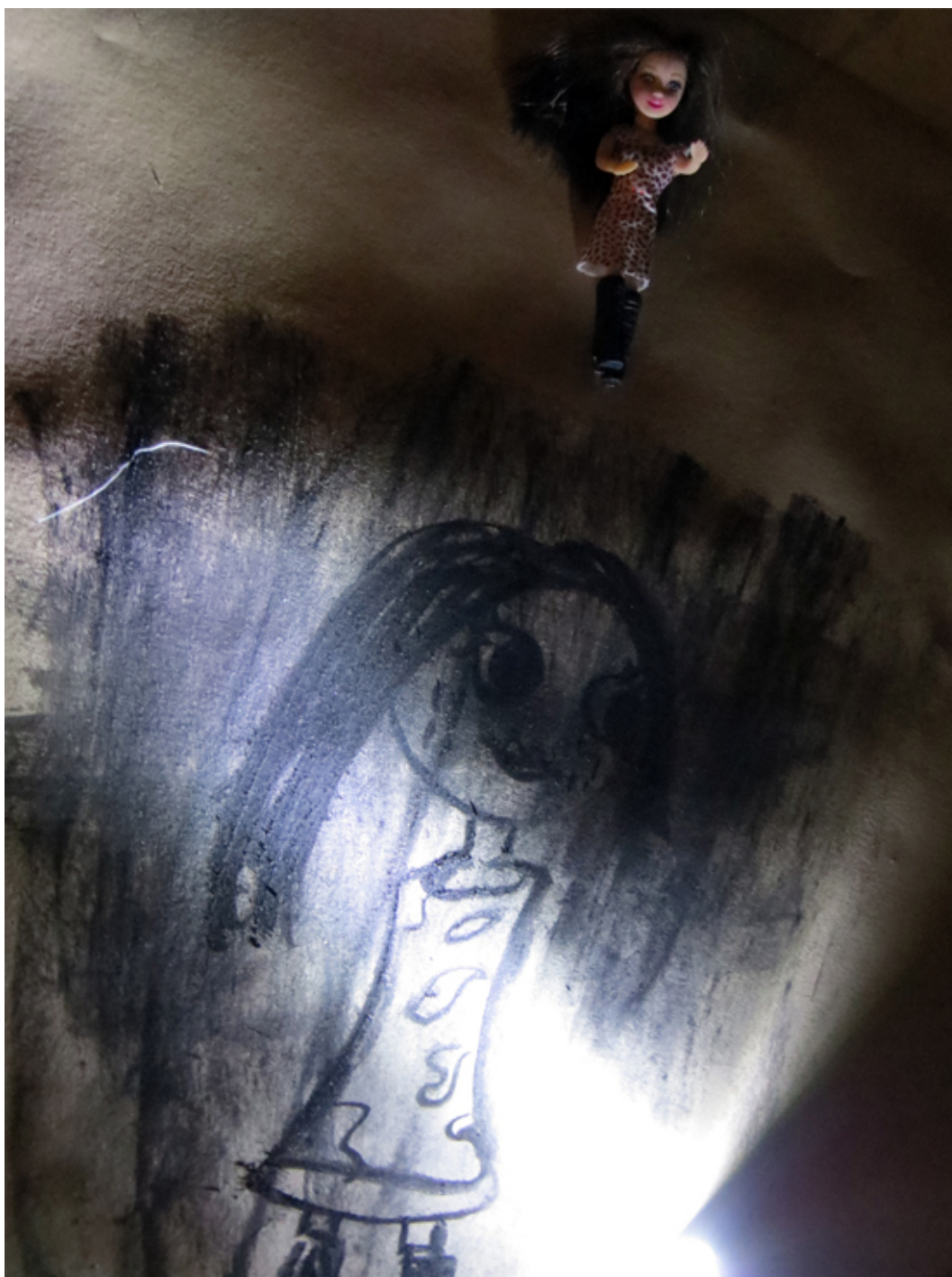


# Drawing by Torchlight
