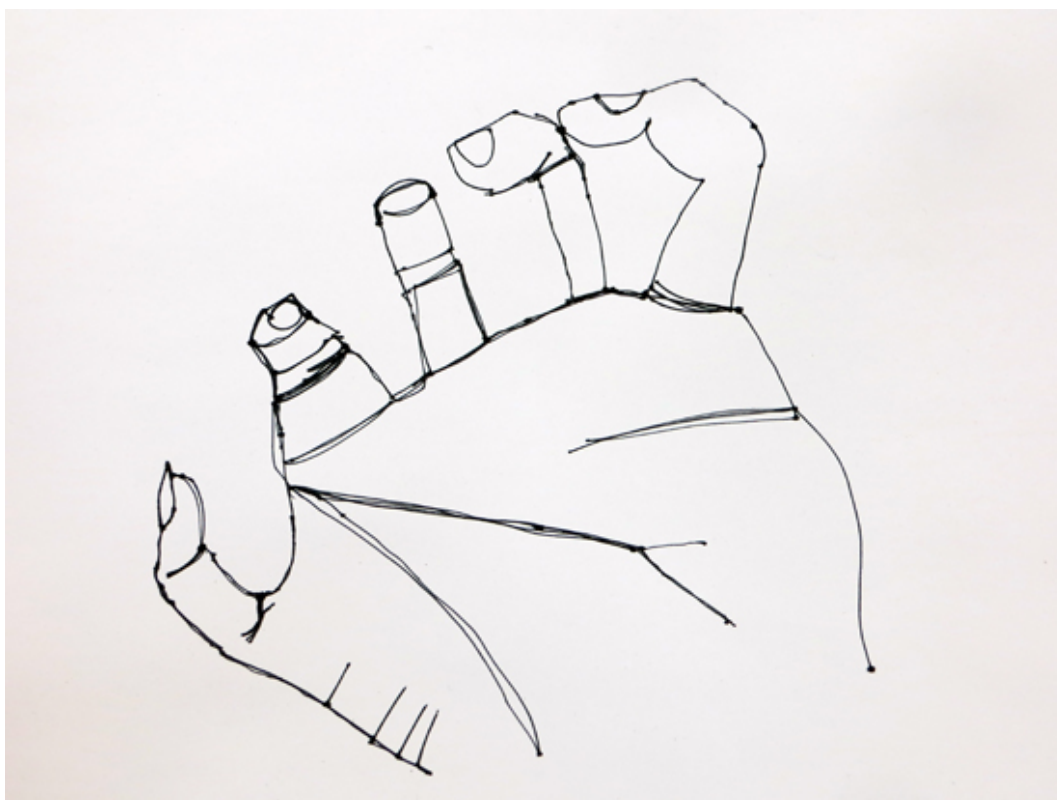


Drawing Hands
