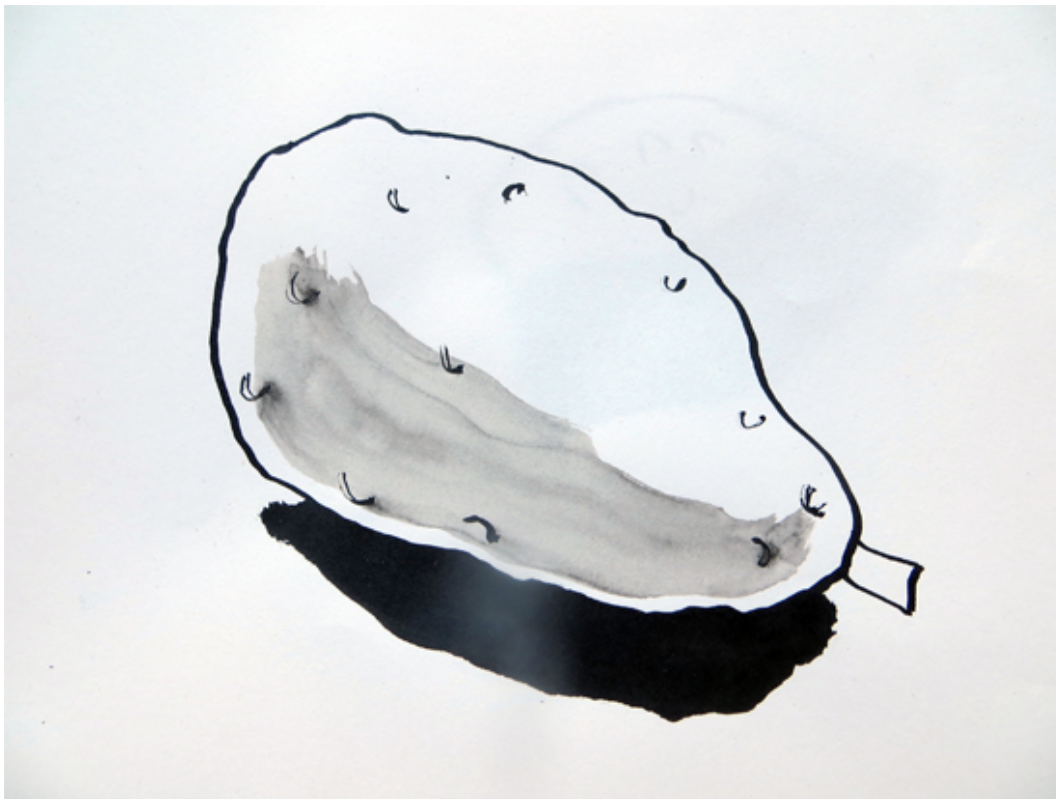


# See Three Shapes
