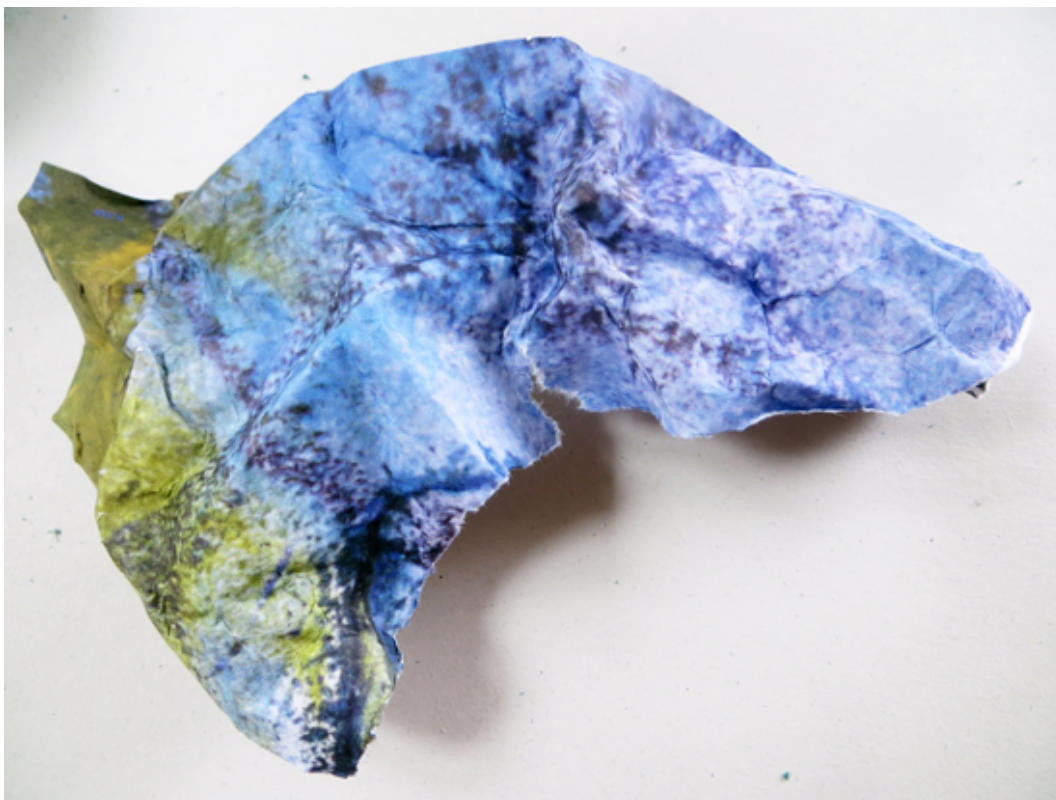


Manipulating Paper: Turning 2D into 3D
