Build an understanding of painting as an activity and outcome, and develop skills to help facilitate a creative and inclusive exploration of painting in others.

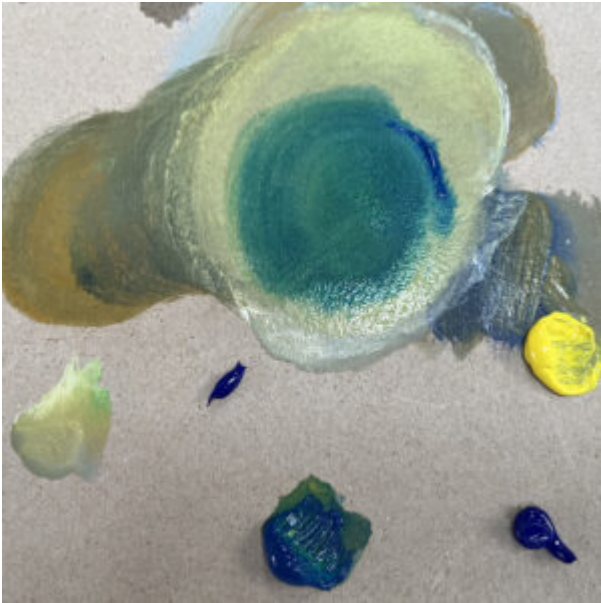

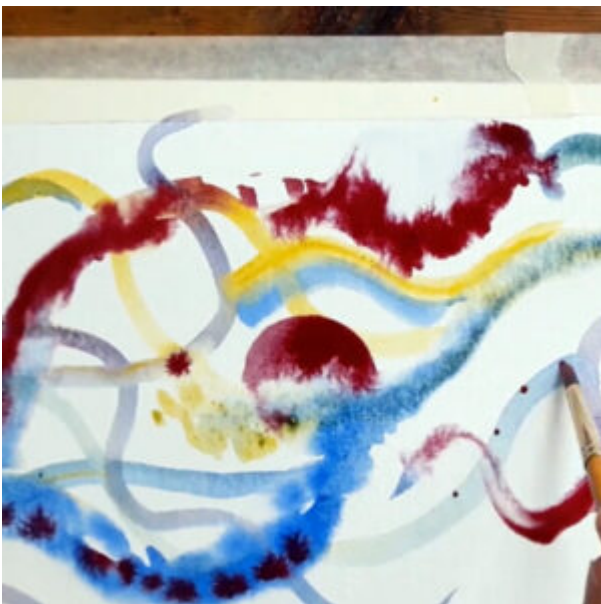

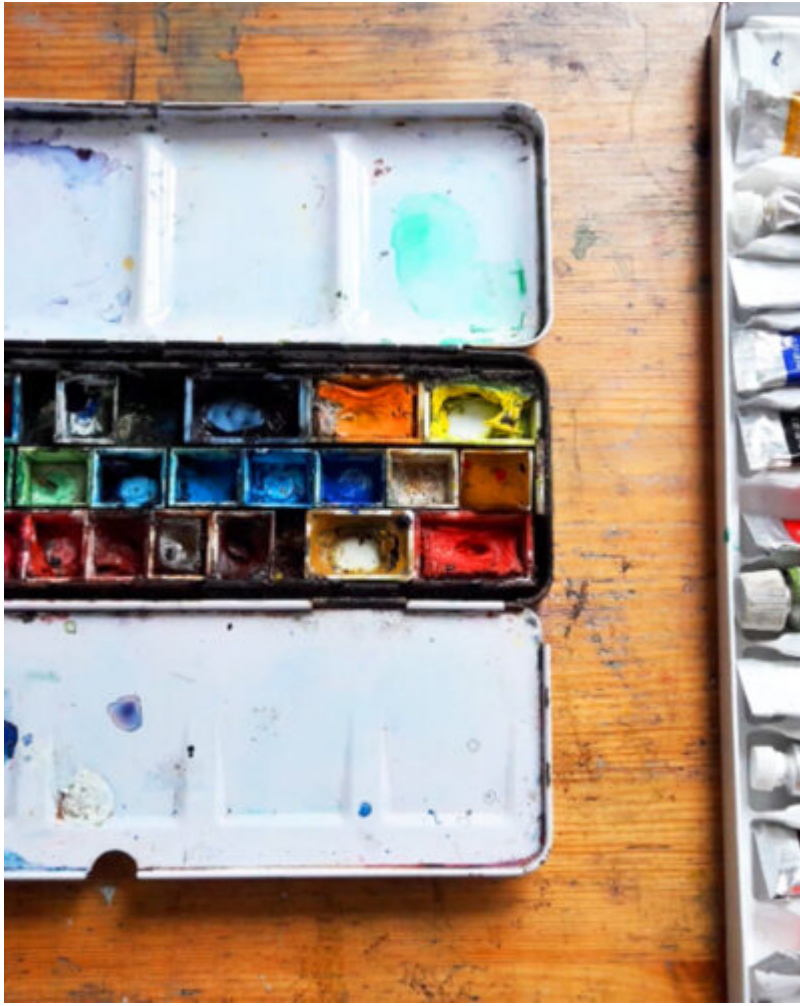

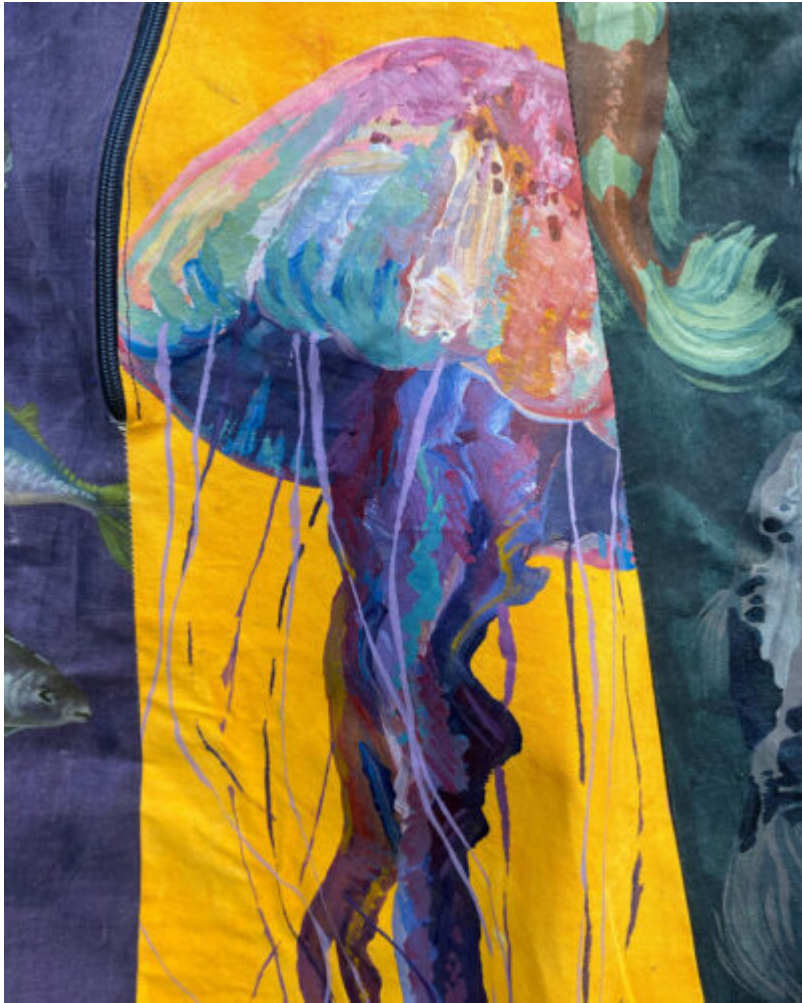
Explore Painting Media
