

CPD Recording: Spaces and Skills to Nurture Creative Thought & Action

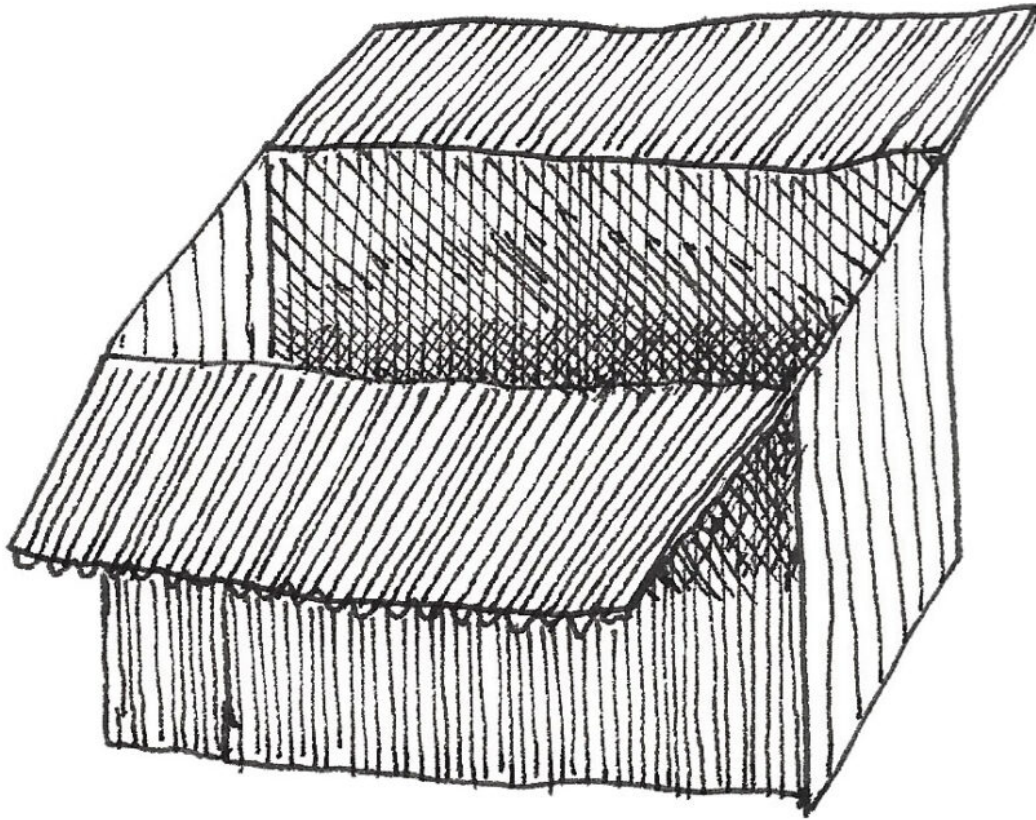
