In this post, you will find a session recording aimed at those based in international settings, such as international schools or home schooling, in which we explored what AccessArt can offer the communities represented worldwide.

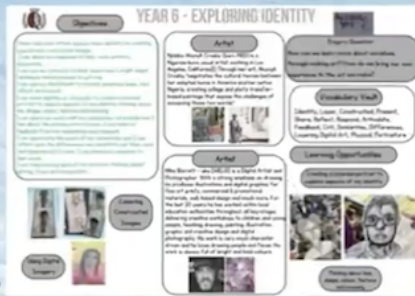
In the session, we were joined by two international schools using AccessArt to share how they have adapted our resources to enrich their curriculum.
