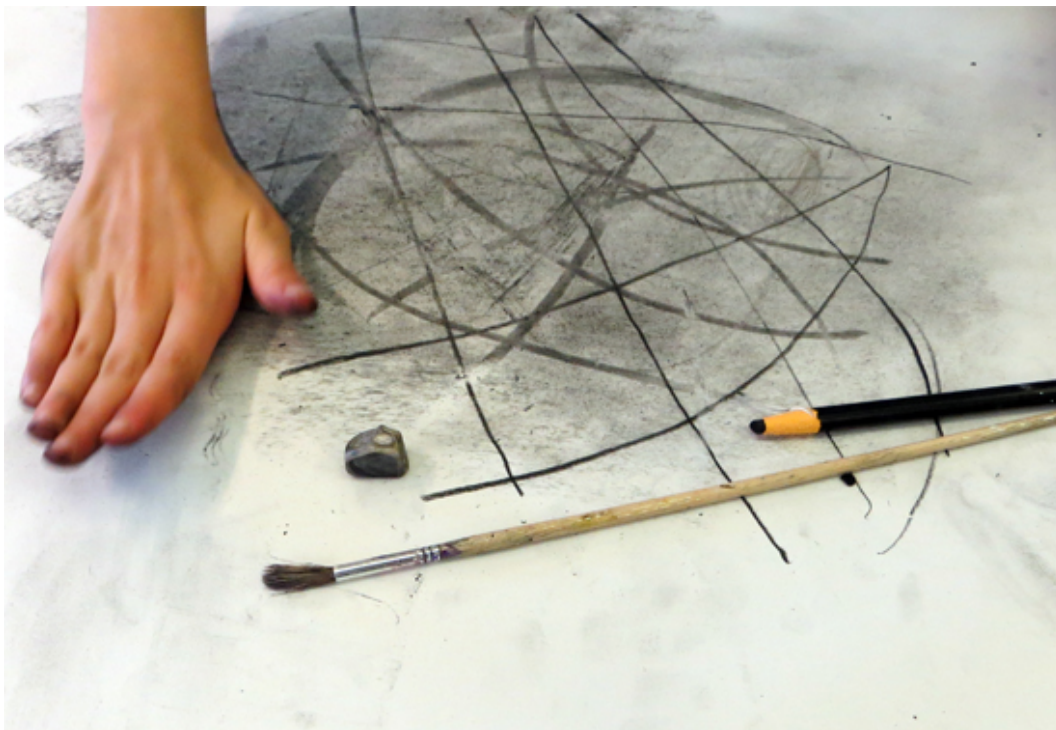


Set Design with Primary Aged Children

Charcoal Warm-Up Exercise for Set Design with Primary Aged Children

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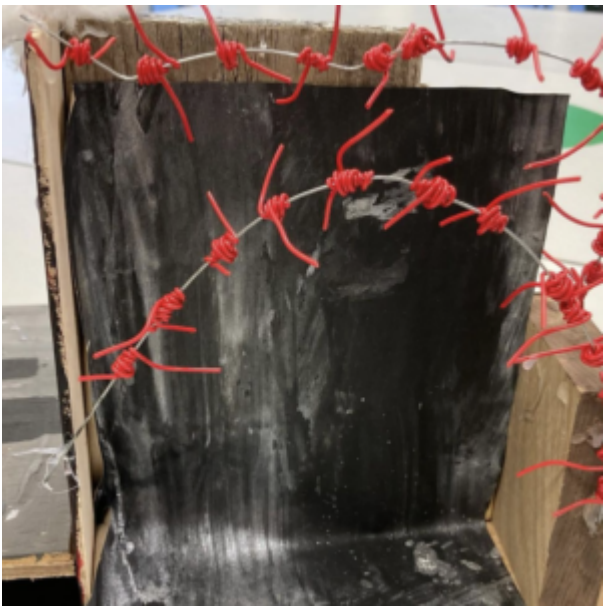
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
