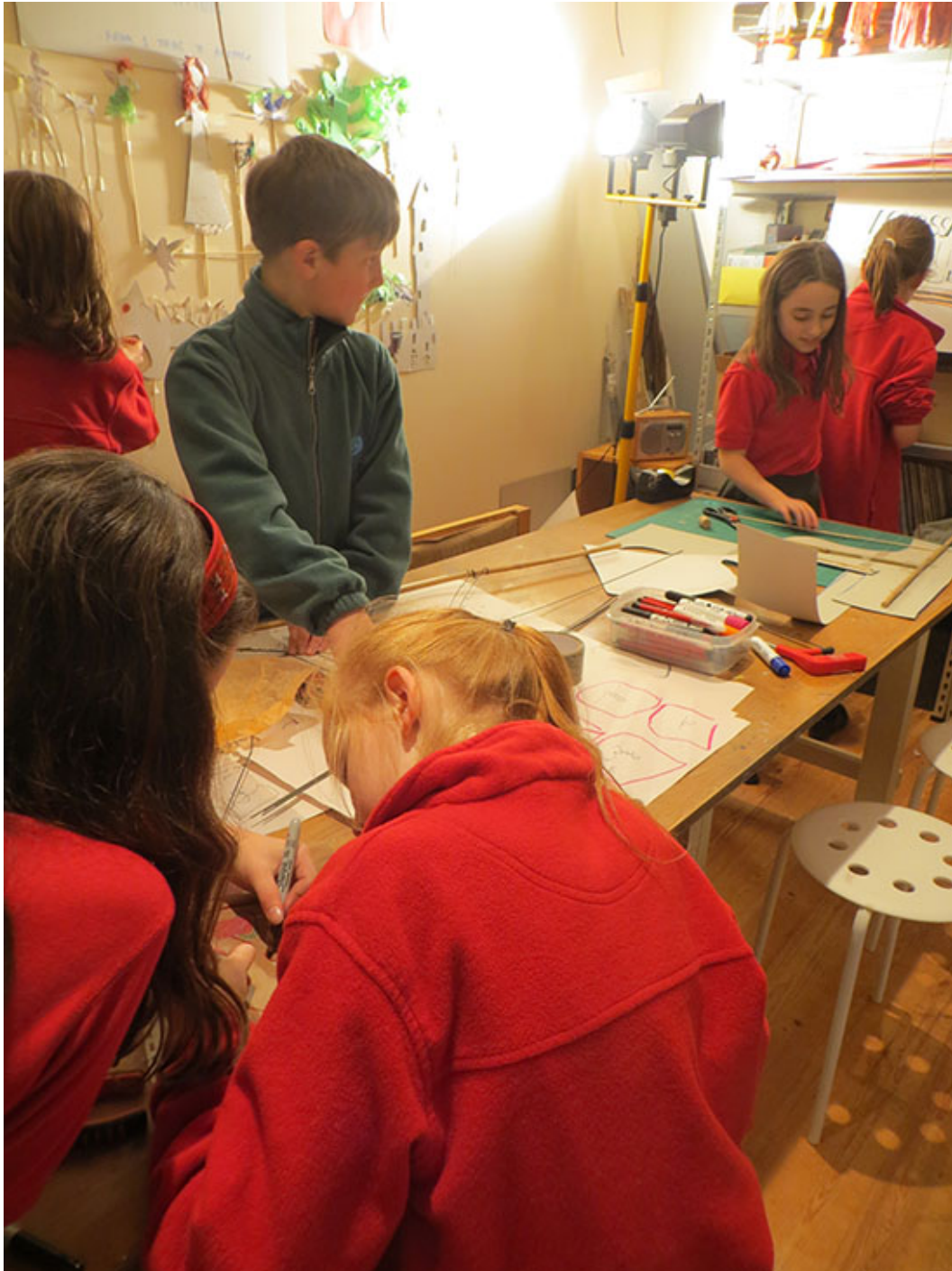


Shipwrecked! A Shadow Puppet Play by Children Aged 10
