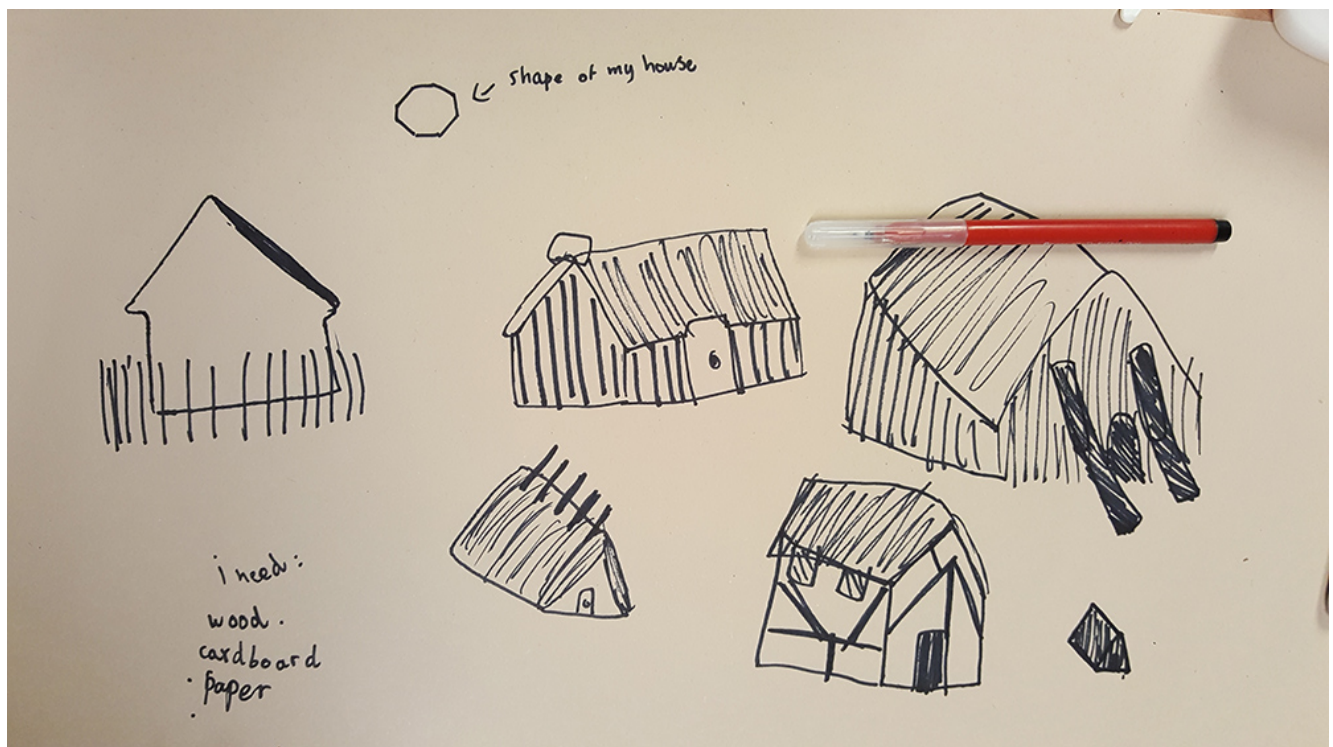


# Show Me What You See: Drawing Inspired by Anglo Saxon Architecture
