

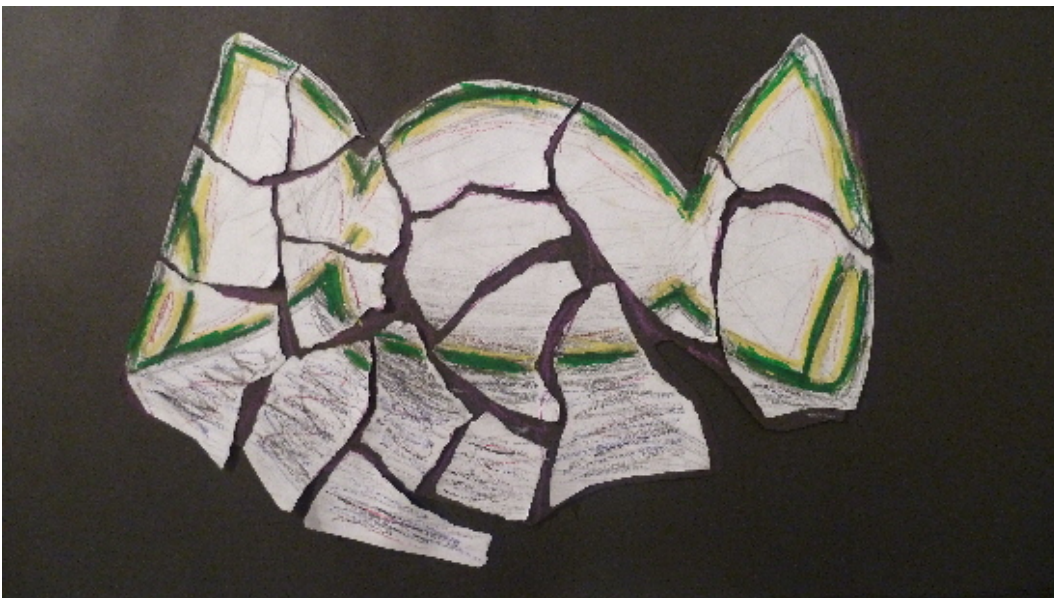
Studio Time – Time to Develop Ideas and Processes
