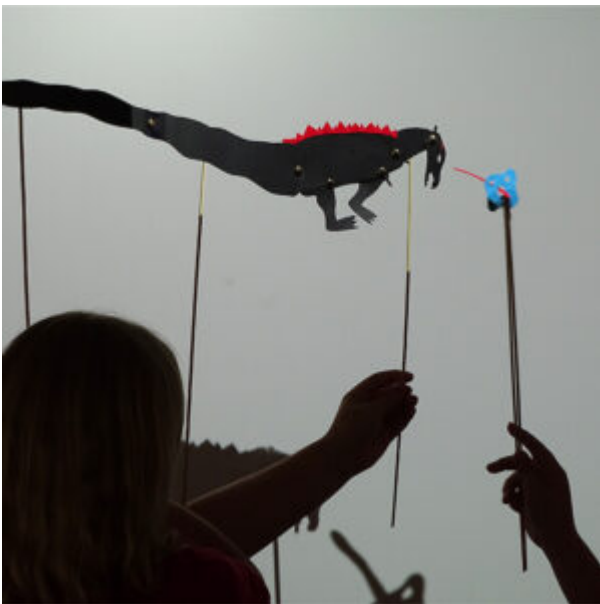

Teenagers Improvise a Shadow Puppet Play

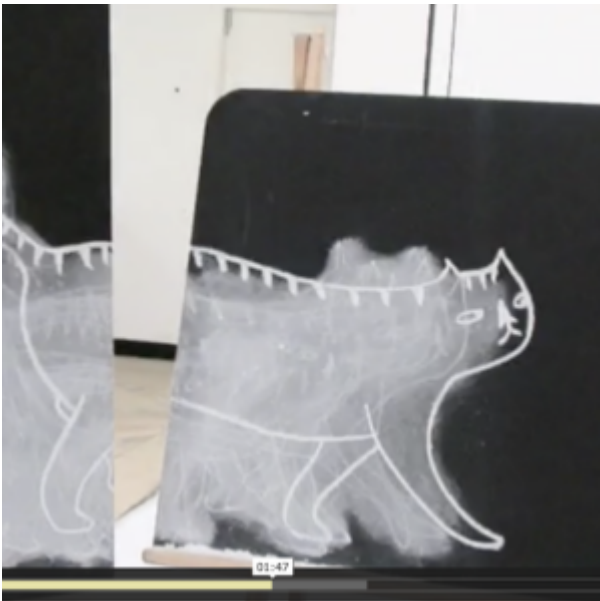
