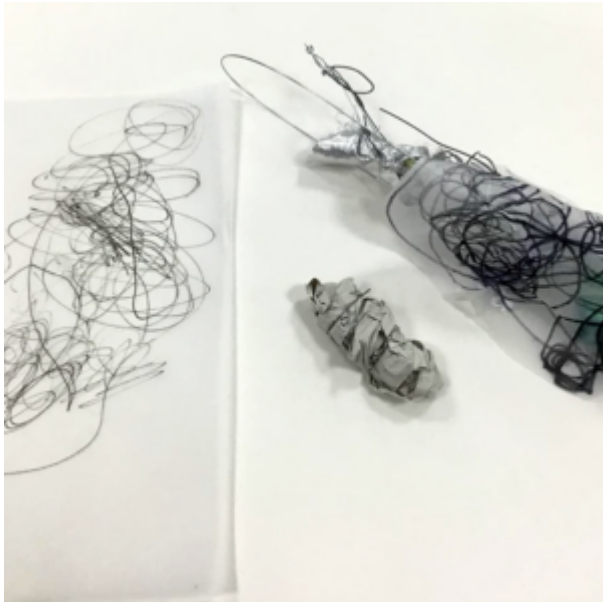

Making a Washing Line Sketchbook

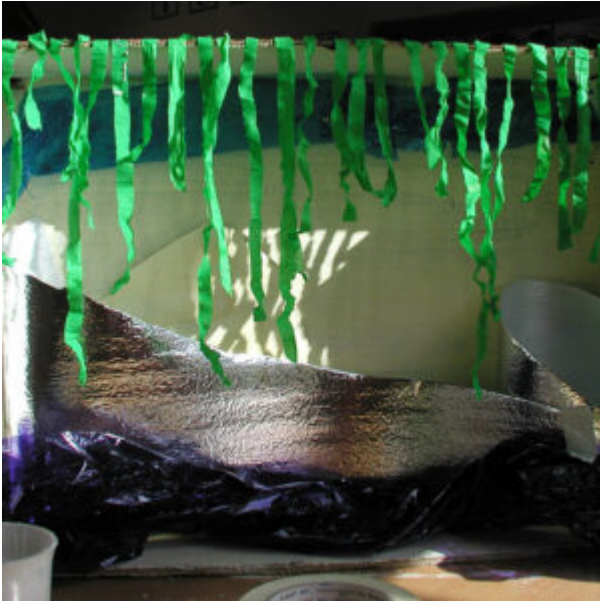
