This is followed by access to the Courses section on the AccessArt website, where you'll find instructions for self-guided learning – fully accessible and easy to follow. This will include resources on the AccessArt website and links to activities and approaches for you to absorb and try in your own time and space. You are then invited to a final live Zoom Reflection Session with course participants so that you can feedback, discuss and reflect upon your experience.

### Flexible, Accessible and Adaptable

Our modular structure enables you to take the courses which feel most relevant to you. You can choose to take all modules in their sequential order, take the modules out of order at the times which work best for you, or just choose one or more module which you feel is particularly relevant to your practice.

Upon completion of each module, attendees will receive a module certificate so that participation can be recorded as part of individual and whole-school CPD provision, supporting ongoing professional learning and practice.
