

The ABC of Tools – PDF Download

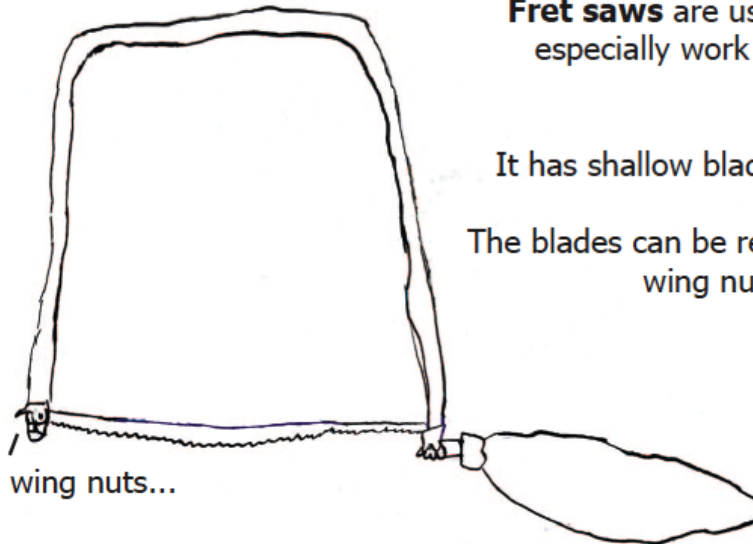
